ZECHARIAH

CHAPTER 1

IN the eighth month, in the second year of Darius, came the word of YAHWAH unto Zechariah, the son of Berechiah, the son of Iddo the prophet, saying,

YAHWAH has been sore displeased with your fathers.

Therefore say you unto them, Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; Turn you all unto me, said YAHWAH of Hosts, and I will turn unto you, said YAHWAH of Hosts.

Be you all not as your fathers, unto whom the former prophets have cried, saying, Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; Turn you all now from your evil ways, and *from* your evil doings: but they did not hear, nor hearken unto me, said YAHWAH.

Your fathers, where *are* they? and the prophets, do they live forever?

But my words and my statutes, which I commanded my servants the prophets, did they not take hold of your fathers? and they returned and said, Like as YAHWAH of Hosts thought to do unto us, according to our ways, and according to our doings, so has he dealt with us.

Upon the four and twentieth day of the eleventh month, which *is* the month Sebat, in the second year of Darius, came the word of YAHWAH unto Zechariah, the son of Berechiah, the son of Iddo the prophet, saying,

I saw by night, and behold a man riding upon a red horse, and he stood among the myrtle trees that were in the bottom; and behind him were there red horses, speckled, and white.

Then said I, O my Lord, what *are* these? And the angel that talked with me said to me, I will show you what these be.

And the man that stood among the myrtle trees answered and said, These *are they* whom YAHWAH has sent to walk to and fro through the land.

And they answered the angel of YAHWAH that stood among the myrtle trees, and said, We have walked to and fro through the land, and, behold, all the land sits still, and is at rest.

Then the angel of YAHWAH answered and said, O YAHWAH of Hosts, how long will you not have mercy on Jerusalem and on the cities of Judah, against which you have had indignation these seventy years?

And YAHWAH answered the angel that talked with me with good words and comfortable words.

So the angel that communed with me said to me, Cry you, saying, Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; I am zealous for Jerusalem and for Zion with a great zeal.

And I am very sore displeased with the nations *that are* at ease: for I was but *a* little displeased, and they helped forward the affliction.

Therefore thus said YAHWAH; I am returned to Jerusalem with mercies: my house shall be built in it, said YAHWAH of Hosts, and *a* line shall be stretched forth upon Jerusalem.

Cry yet, saying, Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; My cities through prosperity shall yet be spread abroad; and YAHWAH shall yet comfort Zion, and shall yet choose Jerusalem.

Then lifted I up my eyes, and saw, and behold four horns.

And I said to the angel that talked with me, What be these? And he answered me, These are the horns which have scattered Judah, Israel, and Jerusalem.

And YAHWAH showed me four carpenters.

Then said I, What come these to do? And he spoke, saying, These *are* the horns which have scattered Judah, so that no man did lift up his head: but these are come to fray them, to cast out the horns of the nations, which lifted up *their* horn over the land of Judah to scatter it.

CHAPTER 2

I LIFTED up my eyes again, and looked, and behold a man with a measuring line in his hand.

Then said I, Where go you? And he said to me, To measure Jerusalem, to see what *is* the breadth thereof, and what *is* the length thereof.

And, behold, the angel that talked with me went forth, and another angel went out to meet him,

And said to him, Run, speak to this young man, saying, Jerusalem shall be inhabited *as* towns without walls for the multitude of adamites and beasts therein:

For, behold, I will shake my hand upon them, and they shall be *a* spoil to their servants: and you all shall know that YAHWAH of Hosts has sent me.

Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion: for, behold, I come, and I will dwell in the midst of you, said YAHWAH. And many nations shall be joined to YAHWAH in that day, and shall be my people: and I will dwell in the midst of you, and you shall know that YAHWAH of Hosts has sent me unto you.

And YAHWAH shall inherit Judah his portion in the sanctified land, and shall choose Jerusalem again.

Be silent, O all flesh, before YAHWAH: for he is raised up out of his sanctified habitation.

CHAPTER 3

And the angel of YAHWAH protested unto YAHWASUA, saying,

Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; If you will walk in my ways, and if you will keep my charge, then you shall also judge my house, and shall also keep my courts, and I will give you places to walk among these that stand by.

Hear now, O YAHWASUA the high priest, you, and your fellows that sit before you: for they *are* men wondered at: for, behold, I will bring forth my servant the BRANCH.

For behold the stone that I have laid before YAHWASUA; upon one stone *shall be* seven eyes: behold, I will engrave the graving thereof, said YAHWAH of Hosts, and I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day.

In that day, said YAHWAH of Hosts, shall you all call every man his neighbour under the vine and under the fig tree.

CHAPTER 4

AND the angel that talked with me came again, and waked me, as a man that is wakened out of his sleep,

And said to me, What see you? And I said, I have looked, and behold a Lamp all of gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven Lamps thereon, and seven pipes to the seven Lamps, which are upon the top thereof:

And two olive trees by it, one upon the right *side* of the bowl, and the other upon the left *side* thereof.

So I answered and spoke to the angel that talked with me, saying, What are these, my Lord?

Then the angel that talked with me answered and said to me, Know you not what these be? And I said, No, my Lord.

Then he answered and spoke unto me, saying, This *is* the word of YAHWAH unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, said YAHWAH of Hosts.

Who are you, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it.

Moreover the word of YAHWAH came unto me, saying,

The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house; his hands shall also finish it; and you shall know that YAHWAH of Hosts has sent me unto you.

For who has despised the day of small things? for they shall rejoice, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel *with* those seven; they *are* the eyes of YAHWAH, which run to and fro through the whole land.

Then answered I, and said to him, What *are* these two olive trees upon the right *side* of the Lamp and upon the left *side* thereof?

And I answered again, and said to him, What *be these* two olive branches which through the two golden pipes empty the golden *oil* out of themselves?

And he answered me and said, Know you not what these be? And I said, No, my Lord.

Then said he, These are the two Sons of the oil, that stand by the Lord of the whole land.

CHAPTER 5

THEN I turned, and lifted up my eyes, and looked, and behold a flying roll.

And he said to me, What see you? And I answered, I see a flying roll; the length thereof is twenty cubits, and the breadth thereof ten cubits.

Then said he unto me, This is the curse that goes forth over the face of the whole land: for every one that steals shall be cut off as on this side according to it; and every one that swears shall be cut off as on that side according to it.

I will bring it forth, said YAHWAH of Hosts, and it shall enter into the house of the thief, and into the house of him that swears falsely by my name: and it shall remain in the midst of his house, and shall consume it with the timber thereof and the stones thereof.

Then the angel that talked with me went forth, and said to me, Lift up now your eyes, and see what *is* this that goes forth.

And I said, What is it? And he said, This is an ephah that goes forth. He said moreover, This is their resemblance through all the land.

And, behold, there was lifted up a talent of lead: and this is a woman that sits in the midst of the ephah.

And he said, This *is* wickedness. And he cast it into the midst of the ephah; and he cast the weight of lead upon the mouth thereof.

Then lifted I up my eyes, and looked, and, behold, there came out two women, and the spirit *was* in their wings; for they had wings like the wings of *a* stork: and they lifted up the ephah between the land and the heaven.

Then said I to the angel that talked with me, Where do these bear the ephah?

And he said to me, To build it *a* house in the land of the Chaldeans: and it shall be established, and set there upon her own base.

CHAPTER 6

AND I turned, and lifted up my eyes, and looked, and, behold, there came four chariots out from between two mountains; and the mountains *were* mountains of brass.

In the first chariot were red horses; and in the second chariot black horses;

And in the third chariot white horses; and in the fourth chariot grisled and bay horses.

Then I answered and said to the angel that talked with me, What are these, my Lord?

And the angel answered and said to me, These *are* the four spirits of the heavens, which go forth from standing before the Lord of all the land.

The black horses which *are* therein go forth into the north land; and the white go forth after them; and the grisled go forth toward the south land.

And the bay went forth, and sought to go that they might walk to and fro through the land: and he said, Get you

hence, walk to and fro through the land. So they walked to and fro through the land.

Then cried he upon me, and spoke unto me, saying, Behold, these that go toward the north land have quieted my spirit in the north land.

And the word of YAHWAH came unto me, saying,

Take of *them of* the captivity, *even* of Heldai, of Tobijah, and of Jedaiah, which are come from Babylon, and come you the same day, and go into the house of Josiah the son of Zephaniah;

Then take silver and gold, and make crowns, and set *them* upon the head of YAHWASUA the son of Josedech, the high priest;

And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaks YAHWAH of Hosts, saying, Behold the man whose name *is* The BRANCH; and he shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the temple of YAHWAH:

Even he shall build the temple of YAHWAH; and he shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon his throne; and he shall be *a* priest upon his throne: and the counsel of peace shall be between them both.

And the crowns shall be to Helem, and to Tobijah, and to Jedaiah, and to Hen the son of Zephaniah, for *a* memorial in the temple of YAHWAH.

And they *that are* far off shall come and build in the temple of YAHWAH, and you all shall know that YAHWAH of Hosts has sent me unto you. And *this* shall come to pass, if you all will diligently obey the voice of YAHWAH ELOHEEM.

CHAPTER 7

AND it came to pass in the fourth year of king Darius, *that* the word of YAHWAH came unto Zechariah in the fourth *day* of the ninth month, *even* in Chisleu;

When they had sent unto the house of God Sherezer and Regemmelech, and their men, to pray before YAHWAH,

Should you all not hear the words which YAHWAH has cried by the former prophets, when Jerusalem was inhabited and in prosperity, and the cities thereof round about her, when men inhabited the south and the plain? And the word of YAHWAH came unto Zechariah, saying,

Thus speaks YAHWAH of Hosts, saying, Execute true judgment, and show mercy and compassions every man to his brother:

And oppress not the widow, nor the fatherless, the stranger, nor the poor; and let none of you imagine evil against his brother in your heart.

But they refused to hearken, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear.

Yes, they made their hearts *as an* adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which YAHWAH of Hosts has sent in his spirit by the former prophets: therefore came *a* great wrath from YAHWAH of Hosts.

Therefore it is come to pass, *that* as he cried, and they would not hear; so they cried, and I would not hear, said YAHWAH of Hosts:

But I scattered them with a whirlwind among all the nations whom they knew not. Thus the land was desolate after them, that no man passed through nor returned: for they laid the pleasant land desolate.

CHAPTER 8

AGAIN the word of YAHWAH of Hosts came to me, saying,

Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; I was zealous for Zion with great zeal, and I was zealous for her with great fury.

Thus said YAHWAH; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called *a* city of truth; and the mountain of YAHWAH of Hosts the sanctified mountain.

Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; There shall yet old men and old women dwell in the streets of Jerusalem, and every man with his staff in his hand for very age.

And the streets of the city shall be full of boys and girls playing in the streets thereof.

Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; If it be marvellous in the eyes of the remnant of this people in these days, should it also be marvellous in my eyes? said YAHWAH of Hosts.

Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; Behold, I will DELIVER my people from the east land, and from the west land; And I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and they shall be my people, and I am their ELOHEEM, in truth and in righteousness.

Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; Let your hands be strong, you all that hear in these days these words by the mouth of the prophets, which *were* in the day *that* the foundation of the house of YAHWAH of Hosts was laid, that the temple might be built.

For before these days there was no hire for adamites, nor any hire for beast; neither was there any peace to him that went out or came in because of the affliction: for I set all adamites every one against his neighbour.

But now I will not be unto the residue of this people as in the former days, said YAHWAH of Hosts.

And it shall come to pass, *that* as you all were *a* curse among the nations, O house of Judah, and house of Israel; so will I DELIVER you, and you all shall be *a* blessing: fear not, *but* let your hands be strong.

For thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; As I thought to punish you, when your fathers provoked me to wrath, said YAHWAH of Hosts, and I turned not:

So again have I thought in these days to do well unto Jerusalem and to the house of Judah: fear you all not.

These *are* the things that you all shall do; Speak you all every man the Truth to his neighbour; execute the judgment of truth and peace in your gates:

And let none of you imagine evil in your hearts against his neighbour; and love no false oath: for all these *are things* that I hate, said YAHWAH.

And the word of YAHWAH of Hosts came unto me, saying,

Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; The fast of the fourth *month*, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts; therefore love the Truth and peace.

Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; *It shall* yet *come to pass*, that there shall come people, and the inhabitants of many cities:

And the inhabitants of one *city* shall go to another, saying, Let us go speedily to pray before YAHWAH, and to seek YAHWAH of Hosts: I will go also.

Yes, many people and strong nations shall come to seek YAHWAH of Hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before YAHWAH.

Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; In those days *it shall come to pass*, that ten men shall take hold out of all languages of the nations, even shall take hold of the skirt of him that is of Judah, saying, We will go with you: for we have heard *that* the ELOHEEM *is* with you.

CHAPTER 9

THE burden of the word of YAHWAH in the land of Hadrach, and Damascus *shall be* the rest thereof: when the eyes of adamites, as of all the tribes of Israel, *shall be* toward YAHWAH.

And Hamath also shall border thereby; Tyrus, and Zidon, though it be very wise.

And Tyrus did build herself a strong hold, and heaped up silver as the dust, and fine gold as the mire of the streets.

Behold, the Lord will cast her out, and he will smite her power in the sea; and she shall be devoured with fire.

Ashkelon shall see *it*, and fear; Gaza also *shall see it*, and be very sorrowful, and Ekron; for her expectation shall be ashamed; and the king shall perish from Gaza, and Ashkelon shall not be inhabited.

And a mixed race person shall dwell in Ashdod, and I will cut off the pride of the Philistines.

And I will take away his blood out of his mouth, and his abominations from between his teeth: but he that remains, even he, *shall be* for ELOHEEM, and he shall be as *a* governor in Judah, and Ekron as *a* Jebusite.

And I will encamp about my house because of the army, because of him that passes by, and because of him that returns: and no oppressor shall pass through them anymore: for now have I seen with my eyes.

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, your King comes to you: he *is* just, and having DELIVERANCE; lowly, and mounted upon *an* ass, *a* colt, and the son of *a* beast of burden.

And I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim, and the horse from Jerusalem, and the battle bow shall be cut off: and he shall speak peace unto the nations: and his dominion *shall be* from sea *even* to sea, and from the river *even* to the ends of the land.

As for you also, by the blood of your covenant I have sent forth your prisoners out of the pit wherein is no water

Turn you to the strong hold, you all prisoners of confidence: even today do I declare *that* I will render double unto you;

When I have bent Judah for me, filled the bow with Ephraim, and raised up your sons, O Zion, against your sons, O Greece, and made you as the sword of *a* mighty *man*.

And YAHWAH shall be seen over them, and his arrow shall go forth as the Lightning: and the Lord YAHWAH shall blow the trumpet, and shall go with whirlwinds of the south.

YAHWAH of Hosts shall defend them; and they shall devour, and subdue with sling stones; and they shall drink, *and* make *a* noise as through wine; and they shall be filled like bowls, *and* as the corners of the altar.

And YAHWAH ELOHEEM shall DELIVER them in that day as the flock of his people: for *they shall be as* the stones of *a* crown, lifted up as *an* ensign upon his land.

For how great is his goodness, and how great is his beauty! grain shall make the young men cheerful, and new wine the maids.

CHAPTER 10

ASK you all of YAHWAH rain in the time of the latter rain; so YAHWAH shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.

For the idols have spoken vanity, and the diviners have seen *a* lie, and have told false dreams; they comfort in vain: therefore they went their way as *a* flock, they were troubled, because *there was* no shepherd.

My anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for YAHWAH of Hosts has visited his flock the house of Judah, and has made them as his goodly horse in the battle.

Out of him came forth the corner, out of him the nail, out of him the battle bow, out of him every oppressor together.

And they shall be as mighty *men*, which tread down *their enemies* in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because YAHWAH *is* with them, and the riders on horses shall be confounded.

And I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will DELIVER the house of Joseph, and I will bring them again to place them; for I have mercy upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off: for I *am* YAHWAH ELOHEEM, and will hear them.

And *they of* Ephraim shall be like *a* mighty *man*, and their heart shall rejoice as through wine: yes, their children shall see *it*, and be glad; their heart shall rejoice in YAHWAH.

I will hiss for them, and gather them; for I have redeemed them: and they shall increase as they have increased.

And I will sow them among the people: and they shall remember me in far countries; and they shall live with their children, and turn again.

I will bring them again also out of the land of Egypt, and gather them out of Assyria; and I will bring them into the land of Gilead and Lebanon; and *place* shall not be found for them.

And he shall pass through the sea with affliction, and shall smite the waves in the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall dry up: and the pride of Assyria shall be brought down, and the rod of Egypt shall depart away.

And I will strengthen them in YAHWAH; and they shall walk up and down in his name, said YAHWAH.

CHAPTER 11

OPEN your doors, O Lebanon, that the fire may devour your cedars.

Howl, fir tree; for the cedar is fallen; because the mighty are spoiled: howl, O you all oaks of Bashan; for the forest of the vintage is come down.

There is a voice of the howling of the shepherds; for their glory is spoiled: a voice of the roaring of young lions; for the pride of Jordan is spoiled.

Thus said YAHWAH ELOHEEM; Feed the flock of the slaughter;

Whose possessors slay them, and hold themselves not guilty: and they that sell them say, Blessed be YAHWAH; for I am rich: and their own shepherds pity them not.

For I will no more pity the inhabitants of the land, said YAHWAH: but, behold, I will deliver the adamites every one into his neighbour's hand, and into the hand of his king: and they shall smite the land, and out of their hand I will not deliver *them*.

And I will feed the flock of slaughter, *even* you, O poor of the flock. And I took unto me two staves; the one I called Beauty, and the other I called Bands; and I fed the flock.

Three shepherds also I cut off in one month; and my person lothed them, and their person also abhorred me.

Then said I, I will not feed you: that that dies, let it die; and that that is to be cut off, let it be cut off; and let the rest eat every one the flesh of another.

And I took my staff, *even* Beauty, and cut it asunder, that I might break my covenant which I had made with all the people.

And it was broken in that day: and so the poor of the flock that waited upon me knew that it was the word of YAHWAH.

And I said to them, If you all think good, give *me* my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price thirty *pieces* of silver.

And YAHWAH said to me, Cast it unto the potter: *a* goodly price that I was prised at of them. And I took the thirty *pieces* of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of YAHWAH.

Then I cut asunder my other staff, even Bands, that I might break the brotherhood between Judah and Israel.

And YAHWAH said to me. Take unto you yet the instruments of a foolish shepherd.

For, behold, I will raise up *a* shepherd in the land, *which* shall not visit those that be cut off, neither shall seek the young one, nor heal that that is broken, nor feed that that stands still: but he shall eat the flesh of the fat, and tear their claws in pieces.

Woe to the idol shepherd that leaves the flock! the sword *shall be* upon his arm, and upon his right eye: his arm shall be clean dried up, and his right eye shall be utterly darkened.

CHAPTER 12

THE burden of the word of YAHWAH for Israel, said YAHWAH, which stretches forth the heavens, and lays the foundation of the land, and forms the spirit of adamite inside of him.

Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about, when they shall be in the siege both against Judah and against Jerusalem.

And in that day will I make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all people: all that burden themselves with it shall be cut in pieces, though all the nations of the land be gathered together against it.

In that day, said YAHWAH, I will smite every horse with astonishment, and his rider with madness: and I will open my eyes upon the house of Judah, and will smite every horse of the people with blindness.

And the governors of Judah shall say in their heart, The inhabitants of Jerusalem *shall be* my strength in YAHWAH of Hosts the ELOHEEM.

In that day will I make the governors of Judah like *a* hearth of fire among the wood, and like *a* torch of fire in *a* sheaf; and they shall devour all the people round about, on the right hand and on the left: and Jerusalem shall be inhabited again in her own place, *even* in Jerusalem.

YAHWAH also shall DELIVER the tents of Judah first, that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem do not magnify *themselves* against Judah.

In that day shall YAHWAH defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David *shall be* as ELOHEEM, as the angel of YAHWAH before them.

And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem.

And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for *his* only *son*, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for *his* firstborn.

In that day shall there be a great mourning in Jerusalem, as the mourning of Hadadrimmon in the valley of Megiddon.

And the land shall mourn, every family apart; the family of the house of David apart, and their wives apart; the family of the house of Nathan apart, and their wives apart;

The family of the house of Levi apart, and their wives apart; the family of Shimei apart, and their wives apart; All the families that remain, every family apart, and their wives apart.

CHAPTER 13

IN that day there shall be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.

And it shall come to pass in that day, said YAHWAH of Hosts, *that* I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land.

And it shall come to pass, *that* when any shall yet prophesy, then his father and his mother that begat him shall say to him, You shall not live; for you speak lies in the name of YAHWAH: and his father and his mother that begat him shall thrust him through when he prophesies.

And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the prophets shall be ashamed every one of his vision, when he has prophesied; neither shall they wear *a* rough garment to deceive:

But he shall say, I am no prophet, I am a husbandman; for adamites taught me to buy from my youth.

And *one* shall say to him, What *are* these wounds in your hands? Then he shall answer, *Those* with which I was wounded *in* the house of my friends.

Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man *that is* my fellow, said YAHWAH of Hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn my hand upon the little ones.

And it shall come to pass, *that* in all the land, said YAHWAH, two parts therein shall be cut off *and* die; but the third shall be left therein.

And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall call on my name, and I will hear them: I will say, It *is* my people: and they shall say, YAHWAH ELOHEEM.

CHAPTER 14

BEHOLD, the day of YAHWAH comes, and your spoil shall be divided in the midst of you.

For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

Then shall YAHWAH go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.

And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mountain of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mountain of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a

very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

And you all shall flee *to* the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yes, you all shall flee, like as you all fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and YAHWAH ELOHEEM shall come, *and* all the sanctified with you.

And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the Light shall not be clear, *nor* dark:

But it shall be one day which shall be known to YAHWAH, not day, nor night: but it shall come to pass, *that* at evening time it shall be light.

And it shall be in that day, *that* living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be.

And YAHWAH shall be king over all the land: in that day shall there be one YAHWAH, and his name one.

All the land shall be turned as *a* plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the first gate, unto the corner gate, and *from* the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses.

And *men* shall dwell in it, and there shall be no more utter destruction; but Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited.

And this shall be the plague wherewith YAHWAH will smite all the people that have fought against Jerusalem; Their flesh shall consume away while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall consume away in their holes, and their tongue shall consume away in their mouth.

And it shall come to pass in that day, *that a* great tumult from YAHWAH shall be among them; and they shall lay hold every one on the hand of his neighbour, and his hand shall rise up against the hand of his neighbour.

And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the nations round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance.

And so shall be the plague of the horse, of the mule, of the camel, and of the ass, and of all the beasts that shall be in these tents, as this plague.

And it shall come to pass, *that* every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, YAHWAH of Hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles.

And it shall be, *that* whoso will not come up of *all* the families of the land unto Jerusalem to worship the King, YAHWAH of Hosts, even upon them shall be no rain.

And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that *have* no *rain;* there shall be the plague, wherewith YAHWAH will smite the nations that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.

This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.

In that day shall there be upon the bells of the horses, SANCTIFICATION UNTO YAHWAH; and the pots in YAHWAH'S house shall be like the bowls before the altar.

Yes, every pot in Jerusalem and in Judah shall be sanctification unto YAHWAH of Hosts: and all they that sacrifice shall come and take of them, and seethe therein: and in that day there shall be no more the Kanaanite in the house of YAHWAH of Hosts.
