HAGGAI

CHAPTER 1

IN the second year of Darius the king, in the sixth month, in the first day of the month, came the word of YAHWAH by Haggai the prophet unto Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to YAHWASUA the son of Josedech, the high priest, saying,

Thus speaks YAHWAH of Hosts, saying, This people say, The time is not come, the time that YAHWAH'S house should be built.

Then came the word of YAHWAH by Haggai the prophet, saying,

Is it time for you, O you all, to dwell in your cieled houses, and this house lie waste?

Now therefore thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; Consider your ways.

You all have sown much, and bring in little; you all eat, but you all have not enough; you all drink, but you all are not filled with drink; you all clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earns wages earns wages *to put it* into *a* bag with holes.

Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; Consider your ways.

Go up to the mountain, and bring wood, and build the house; and I will take pleasure in it, and I will be glorified, said YAHWAH.

You all looked for much, and, behold, *it came* to little; and when you all brought *it* home, I did blow upon it. Why? said YAHWAH of Hosts. Because of my house that *is* waste, and you all run every man unto his own house.

Therefore the heaven over you is stayed from dew, and the land is stayed from her fruit.

And I called for *a* drought upon the land, and upon the mountains, and upon the grain, and upon the new wine, and upon the oil, and upon *that* which the ground brings forth, and upon adamites, and upon beasts, and upon all the labor of the hands.

Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and YAHWASUA the son of Josedech, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the voice of YAHWAH ELOHEEM, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as YAHWAH ELOHEEM had sent him, and the people did fear before YAHWAH.

Then spoke Haggai YAHWAH'S messenger in YAHWAH'S message unto the people, saying, I *am* with you, said YAHWAH.

And YAHWAH stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of YAHWASUA the son of Josedech, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people; and they came and did work in the house of YAHWAH of Hosts, the ELOHEEM,

In the four and twentieth day of the sixth month, in the second year of Darius the king.

CHAPTER 2

IN the seventh *month*, in the one and twentieth *day* of the month, came the word of YAHWAH by the prophet Haggai, saying,

Speak now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to YAHWASUA the son of Josedech, the high priest, and to the residue of the people, saying,

Who *is* left among you that saw this house in her first glory? and how do you all see it now? *is it* not in your eyes in comparison of it as nothing?

Yet now be strong, O Zerubbabel, said YAHWAH; and be strong, O YAHWASUA, son of Josedech, the high priest; and be strong, all you all people of the land, said YAHWAH, and work: for I *am* with you, said YAHWAH of Hosts:

According to the word that I covenanted with you when you all came out of Egypt, so my spirit remains among you: fear you all not.

For thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; Yet once, it *is a* little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the land, and the sea, and the dry *land*;

And I will shake all nations, and the persons of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, said YAHWAH of Hosts.

The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, said YAHWAH of Hosts.

The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, said YAHWAH of Hosts: and in this place will I give peace, said YAHWAH of Hosts.

In the four and twentieth *day* of the ninth *month*, in the second year of Darius, came the word of YAHWAH by Haggai the prophet, saying,

Thus said YAHWAH of Hosts; Ask now the priests concerning the law, saying,

If one bear sanctified flesh in the skirt of his garment, and with his skirt do touch bread, or pottage, or wine, or oil, or any meat, shall it be sanctified? And the priests answered and said, No.

Then said Haggai, If *one that is* unclean by *a dead* person touch any of these, shall it be unclean? And the priests answered and said, It shall be unclean.

Then answered Haggai, and said, So *is* this people, and so *is* this nation before me, said YAHWAH; and so *is* every work of their hands; and that which they offer there *is* unclean.

And now, I pray you, consider from this day and upward, from before *a* stone was laid upon *a* stone in the temple of YAHWAH:

Since those *days* were, when *one* came to *a* heap of twenty *measures*, there were *but* ten: when *one* came to the pressfat for to draw out fifty *vessels* out of the press, there were *but* twenty.

I smote you with blasting and with mildew and with hail in all the labors of your hands; yet you all *turned* not to me, said YAHWAH.

Consider now from this day and upward, from the four and twentieth day of the ninth *month*, *even* from the day that the foundation of YAHWAH'S temple was laid, consider *it*.

Is the seed yet in the barn? yes, as yet the vine, and the fig tree, and the pomegranate, and the olive tree, has not brought forth: from this day will I bless *you*.

And again the word of YAHWAH came unto Haggai in the four and twentieth day of the month, saying,

Speak to Zerubbabel, governor of Judah, saying, I will shake the heavens and the land;

And I will overthrow the throne of kingdoms, and I will destroy the strength of the kingdoms of the nations; and I will overthrow the chariots, and those that ride in them; and the horses and their riders shall come down, every one by the sword of his brother.

In that day, said YAHWAH of Hosts, will I take you, O Zerubbabel, my servant, the son of Shealtiel, said YAHWAH, and will make you as *a* signet: for I have chosen you, said YAHWAH of Hosts.
