JOEL

CHAPTER 1

THE word of YAHWAH that came to Joel the son of Pethuel.

Hear this, you all old men, and give ear, all you all inhabitants of the land. Has this been in your days, or even in the days of your fathers?

Tell you all your children of it, and *let* your children *tell* their children, and their children another gene-raceaion.

That which the palmerworm has left has the locust eaten; and that which the locust has left has the cankerworm eaten; and that which the cankerworm has left has the caterpiller eaten.

Awake, you all drunkards, and weep; and howl, all you all drinkers of wine, because of the new wine; for it is cut off from your mouth.

The vine is dried up, and the fig tree languishes; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree, *even* all the trees of the field, are withered: because joy is withered away from the sons of adamites.

Gird yourselves, and lament, you all priests: howl, you all ministers of the altar: come, lie all night in sackcloth, you all ministers of the ELOHEEM: for the meat offering and the drink offering is withholden from the house of the ELOHEEM.

Sanctify you all a fast, call a solemn assembly, gather the elders and all the inhabitants of the land into the house of YAHWAH ELOHEEM, and cry unto YAHWAH,

Alas for the day! for the day of YAHWAH is at hand, and as a destruction from the Almighty shall it come.

Is not the meat cut off before our eyes, ves, joy and gladness from the house of the ELOHEEM?

O YAHWAH, to you will I cry: for the fire has devoured the pastures of the wilderness, and the flame has burned all the trees of the field.

The beasts of the field cry also unto you: for the rivers of waters are dried up, and the fire has devoured the pastures of the wilderness.

CHAPTER 2

BLOW you all the trumpet in Zion, and sound *an* alarm in my sanctified mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of YAHWAH comes, for *it is* near at hand;

A day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and of thick darkness, as the morning spread upon the mountains: a great people and a strong; there has not been ever the like, neither shall be anymore after it, even to the years from gene-race-aion to gene-race-aion.

Like the noise of chariots on the tops of mountains shall they leap, like the noise of a flame of fire that devoures the stubble, as a strong people set in battle array.

They shall run like mighty men; they shall climb the wall like men of war; and they shall march every one on his ways, and they shall not break their ranks:
