PSALM 106

PRAISE you all YAHWAH. O give thanks unto YAHWAH; for *he is* good: for his mercy *endures* forever.
Who can utter the mighty acts of YAHWAH? *who* can show forth all his praise?
Blessed *are* they that keep judgment, *and* he that does righteousness at all times.
Remember me, O YAHWAH, with the favour *that you bear unto* your people: O visit me with your DELIVERANCE;
That I may see the good of your chosen, that I may rejoice in the gladness of your nation, that I may glory with your inheritance.
We have sinned with our fathers, we have committed iniquity, we have done wickedly.
Our fathers understood not your wonders in Egypt; they remembered not the multitude of your mercies; but provoked *him* at the sea, *even* at the Red sea.
Nevertheless he DELIVERED them for his name's sake, that he might make his mighty power to be known.
He rebuked the Red sea also, and it was dried up: so he led them through the deep, as through the wilderness.
And he DELIVERED them from the hand of him that hated *them*, and redeemed them from the hand of the enemy.
And the waters covered their enemies: there was not one of them left.
Then believed they his words; they sang his praise.
They soon forgot his works; they waited not for his counsel:
But lusted exceedingly in the wilderness, and tempted God in the desert.
And he gave them their request; but sent leanness into their person.
They envied Moses also in the camp, *and* Aaron the sanctified of YAHWAH.
The land opened and swallowed up Dathan, and covered the whole national gathering of Abiram.
And *a* fire was kindled in their whole national gathering; the flame burned up the wicked.
They made *a* calf in Horeb, and worshipped the molten image.
Thus they changed their glory into the similitude of *an* ox that eats grass.
They forgot God their DELIVERER, which had done great things in Egypt;
Wondrous works in the land of Ham, *and* terrible things by the Red sea.
Therefore he said that he would destroy them, had not Moses his chosen stood before him in the breach, to turn away his wrath, lest he should destroy *them*.
Yes, they despised the pleasant land, they believed not his word:
But murmured in their tents, *and* hearkened not unto the voice of YAHWAH.
Therefore he lifted up his hand against them, to overthrow them in the wilderness:
To overthrow their seed also among the nations, and to scatter them in the lands.
They joined themselves also unto Baalpeor, and ate the sacrifices of the dead.
Thus they provoked *him* to anger with their inventions: and the plague break in upon them.
Then stood up Phinehas, and executed judgment: and *so* the plague was stayed.
And that was counted unto him for righteousness from gene-race-aion to gene-race-aion forever.
They angered *him* also at the waters of strife, so that it went ill with Moses for their sakes:
Because they provoked his spirit, so that he spoke unadvisedly with his lips.
They did not destroy the peoples, concerning whom YAHWAH commanded them:
But were mingled among the nations, and learned their works.
And they served their idols: which were *a* snare unto them.
Yes, they sacrificed their sons and their daughters unto devils,
And shed innocent blood, *even* the blood of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Kanaan: and the land was polluted with blood.
Thus were they defiled with their own works, and went *a* whoring with their own inventions.

Therefore was the wrath of YAHWAH kindled against his people, insomuch that he abhorred his own inheritance.

And he gave them into the hand of the nations; and they that hated them ruled over them.

Their enemies also oppressed them, and they were brought into subjection under their hand.

Many times did he deliver them; but they provoked *him* with their counsel, and were brought low for their iniquity.

Nevertheless he regarded their affliction, when he heard their cry:

And he remembered for them his covenant, and repented according to the multitude of his mercies.

He made them also to be pitied of all those that carried them captives.

DELIVER us, O YAHWAH ELOHEEM, and gather us from among the nations, to give thanks unto your sanctified name, *and* to triumph in your praise.

Blessed *be* YAHWAH ELOHEEM of Israel from everlasting to everlasting: and let all the people say, Amen.
