PSALM 34

I WILL bless YAHWAH at all times: his praise *shall* continually be in my mouth. My person shall make her boast in YAHWAH: the humble shall hear *thereof*, and be glad. O magnify YAHWAH with me, and let us exalt his name together. I sought YAHWAH, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears. They looked unto him, and were lightened: and their faces were not ashamed. This poor man cried, and YAHWAH heard *him*, and DELIVERED him out of all his troubles. The angel of YAHWAH encamps round about them that fear him, and delivers them. O taste and see that YAHWAH is good: blessed is the man that trusts in him. O fear YAHWAH, you all his sanctified: for there is no want to them that fear him. The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek YAHWAH shall not want any good *thing*. Come, you all children, hearken unto me: I will teach you the fear of YAHWAH. What man is he that desires life, and loves many days, that he may see good? Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking guile. Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it. The eves of YAHWAH are upon the righteous, and his ears are open unto their cry. The face of YAHWAH is against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the land. The righteous cry, and YAHWAH hears, and delivers them out of all their troubles. YAHWAH is near unto them that are of a broken heart; and DELIVERETH such as be of a contrite spirit. Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but YAHWAH delivers him out of them all. He keeps all his bones: not one of them is broken. Evil shall slay the wicked: and they that hate the righteous shall be desolate.
