PSALM 40

Let them be ashamed and confounded together that seek after my person to destroy it; let them be driven backward and put to shame that wish me evil.

Let them be desolate for *a* reward of their shame that say to me, Aha, aha.

Let all those that seek you rejoice and be glad in you: let such as love your deliverance say continually, YAHWAH be magnified.
