PSALM 51

HAVE mercy upon me, O ELOHEEM, according to your lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of your tender mercies blot out my transgressions.

Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin *is* ever before me.

Against you, you only, have I sinned, and done *this* evil in your sight: that you might be justified when you speak, *and* be clear when you judge.

Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.

Behold, you desire truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden *part* you shall make me to know wisdom.

Cast me not away from your presence; and take not your Sanctifying Spirit from me.

Restore unto me the joy of your DELIVERANCE; and uphold me *with your* free spirit.

Then will I teach transgressors your ways; and sinners shall be converted unto you.

Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O ELOHEEM, you ELOHEEM of my deliverance: *and* my tongue shall sing aloud of your righteousness.

O Lord, open you my lips; and my mouth shall show forth your praise.

For you desire not sacrifice; else would I give *it*: you delight not in burnt offering.

The sacrifices to the ELOHEEM *are a* broken spirit: *a* broken and *a* contrite heart, O ELOHEEM, you will not despise.

Do good in your good pleasure unto Zion: build you the walls of Jerusalem.

Then shall you be pleased with the sacrifices of righteousness, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering: then shall they offer bullocks upon your altar.
