PSALM 65

PRAISE waits for you, O ELOHEEM, in Zion: and unto you shall the vow be performed.

O you that hear prayer, unto you shall all flesh come.

Iniquities prevail against me: *as for* our transgressions, you shall purge them away.

Blessed *is the man whom* you choose, and cause to approach *unto you, that* he may dwell in your courts: we shall be satisfied with the goodness of your house, *even* of your sanctified temple.

By terrible things in righteousness will you answer us, O ELOHEEM of our DELIVERANCE; *who are* the trust of all the ends of the land, and of them that are afar off *upon* the sea:

Which by his strength sets fast the mountains; *being* girded with power:

Which stills the noise of the seas, the noise of their waves, and the tumult of the people.

They also that dwell in the uttermost parts are afraid at your tokens: you make the outgoings of the morning and evening to rejoice.
