PSALM 9

I WILL praise *you*, O YAHWAH, with my whole heart; I will show forth all your marvellous works.

I will be glad and rejoice in you: I will sing praise to your name, O you most High.

When my enemies are turned back, they shall fall and perish at your presence.

For you have maintained my right and my cause; you sat in the throne judging right.

You have rebuked the nations, you have destroyed the wicked, you have put out their name into this Age and all Ages.

O you enemy, destructions are come to *a* perpetual end: and you have destroyed cities; their memorial is perished with them.

But YAHWAH shall endure forever: he has prepared his throne for judgment.

And he shall judge the World in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness.

YAHWAH also will be *a* refuge for the oppressed, *a* refuge in times of trouble.

And they that know your name will put their trust in you: for you, YAHWAH, have not forsaken them that seek you.

Sing praises to YAHWAH, which dwells in Zion: declare among the people his doings.

When he makes inquisition for blood, he remembers them: he forgets not the cry of the humble.

Have mercy upon me, O YAHWAH; consider my trouble *which I suffer* of them that hate me, you that lift me up from the gates of death:

That I may show forth all your praise in the gates of the daughter of Zion: I will rejoice in your DELIVERANCE.

The nations are sunk down in the pit *that* they made: in the net which they hid is their own foot taken.

YAHWAH is known *by* the judgment *which* he executes: the wicked is snared in the work of his own hands.

The wicked shall be turned into the grave, *and* all the nations that forget the ELOHEEM.

For the needy shall not always be forgotten: the expectation of the poor shall *not* perish forever.

Arise, O YAHWAH; let not man prevail: let the nations be judged in your sight.

Put them in fear, O YAHWAH: *that* the nations may know themselves *to be but* men.
