PSALM 92

It is a good thing to give thanks unto YAHWAH, and to sing praises unto your name, O most High:

To show forth your lovingkindness in the morning, and your faithfulness every night,

Upon *an* instrument of ten strings, and upon the psaltery; upon the harp with *a* solemn sound.

For you, YAHWAH, have made me glad through your work: I will triumph in the works of your hands.

O YAHWAH, how great are your works! *and* your thoughts are very deep.

A brutish man knows not; neither does *a* fool understand this.

When the wicked spring as the grass, and when all the workers of iniquity do flourish; *it is* that they shall be destroyed forever:

But you, YAHWAH, *are most* high forever.

For, behold, your enemies, O YAHWAH, for, behold, your enemies shall perish; all the workers of iniquity shall be scattered.

But my horn shall you exalt like *the horn of an* unicorn: I shall be nurished with fresh oil.

My eyes also shall see *my desire* on my enemies, *and* my ears shall hear *my desire* of the wicked that rise up against me.

The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like *a* cedar in Lebanon.

Those that be planted in the house of YAHWAH shall flourish in the courts of the ELOHEEM.

They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing;
